We recommend that you wash your finished skeins to remove the spinning oils. The yarn will loft, look brighter, and be more attractive to your customers.

To wash:

- In a top-loading washer, run hot water into the tub. Water can be very warm.
- Add a small amount of mild soap or shampoo.
- Press skeins into the water, there's no need to unwind.
- **Do not agitate!** Soak for several minutes. Spin out the water.
- Remove skeins and refill tub with water the same temperature as the skeins.
- Again press skeins into water and soak. Spin out water.
- Now unwind skeins and hang to dry. Shower curtain hangers make a great holder for the skeins. Take care that the skein stays securely tied in at least one place.
- Once dry, rewind the skeins by taking one end in each hand and twisting in opposite directions. Tuck one end inside the other to secure.

If a top loader is not available, follow the same process in a sink then roll rinsed skeins in a towel to remove excess water.
